Congratulations, you have purchased the finest air filter that money can buy. With proper care, this filter will last 1 million miles or more. This filter can be used in a stock machine, with no modifications required. If any engine modifications have been made tuning/jetting adjustments may be required. There are special installation instructions, so please follow the procedures outlined below to ensure the K&N® Filtercharger® seals properly.

INSTALLATION:

1. Unlatch the two clips and remove the air box lid. **(FIG. 1)**
2. Remove the dirty filter from the air filter housing. **(FIG. 2)**
3. Wipe out any dirt or dust that may be inside the housing.
4. Install the K&N Filtercharger into the air box with the metal clip facing outwards and the arrow pointing toward the bump in the housing. Ensure that the lip on the filter is fully seated behind the bump as shown. **(FIGS. 3 & 4)**
5. Re-install the air box lid to complete the installation.
6. Clean an area on the air box and apply the K&N Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others, who may be working on this vehicle, that this is a washable/re-usable air filter.

THESE INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED EVERY TIME THE FILTER IS SERVICED, OTHERWISE THE FILTER MAY NOT SEAL, AND DAMAGE TO THE ENGINE COULD RESULT.

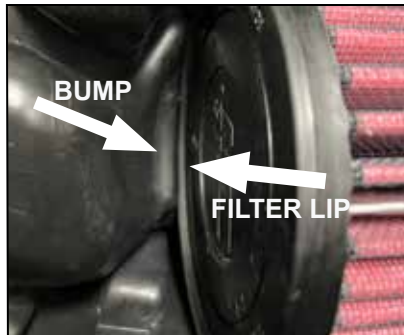
