Congratulations, you have purchased the finest air filter that money can buy. With proper care, this filter will last 1 million miles or more. This filter can be used in a stock machine, with no modifications required. If any engine modifications have been made tuning/jetting adjustments may be required. There are special installation instructions, so please follow the procedures outlined below to ensure the K&N® Filtercharger® seals properly.

INSTALLATION:

- 1. Remove the stock filter.
- 2. Remove the factory o-ring from the stock air filter sealing groove.
- Note: the o-ring will be reused.
- 3. Wipe out any dirt or dust that may be inside the air filter housing.
- 4. Install the o-ring (removed in step 2) onto the K&N Filtercharger. (FIGS. 1 & 2)
- 5. Work the o-ring into the sealing groove so that it sits inside completely flush and is secure. (FIG 3).
- 6. Install the K&N Filtercharger into the air box.

Note: Ensure that the o-ring remains secure in the sealing groove while installing.

- 7. Using the stock screws, secure the K&N Filtercharger to the air box.
- 6. Clean an area on the air box and apply the K&N Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others, who may be working on this vehicle, that this is a washable/re-usable air filter.

THESE INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED EVERY TIME THE FILTER IS SERVICED, OTHERWISE THE FILTER MAY NOT SEAL, AND DAMAGE TO THE ENGINE COULD RESULT.
